HEAR YE, HEAR YE, Cory's one and all The National Cory Family Society will be holding its 4th annual reunion in Salem, MA on August 7th, 8th and 9th. We will be in Salem this year to honor the memory of GILES CORY and his third wife Martha Cory as well as all the others who lost their lives during this sad period of American History. The CORY'S will be there in numbers to remember these accused who were executed on the 300th anniversary of this most important event.

Our reunion headquarters will be the elegant Hawthorne Hotel situated in the heart of Salem across from the Salem Commons, and within walking distance to many historical sights. We will all be gathering together on Friday, August 7th at the Hotel. There will be a hospitality suite available to visit and share some "family moments" before the weekend begins. Please be sure to stop by and pick up your packet of information for the weekend including name tags and agenda. Saturday morning will begin with a one hour walking tour by noted local historian Jim McAllister, who will present us with the "WITCH TRIAL TRAIL". Special emphasis during the tour will be placed on Giles and Martha Cory. Jim has assured me that the walk will be slow and there will be places to sit for those who require it. After the walking tour we will be given a tour of the ESSEX Institute and Salem Witch Museum, which has a diorama of Giles Cory being pressed to death (I'm sure

not as realistic as 300 years ago). The rest of the afternoon is free to rest or to catch lunch somewherein the area.

A very special event will occur about noon as those who wish, gather at the Salem Witch Trials Tercentenary Memorial near the Charter Street Burying Point, one block from the Hotel. This memorial will stand as a permanent memorial to the victims of the trials and "as a reminder that a spirit of tolerance and understanding should prevail among all people." One of the walls of the memorial area will be dedicated to Giles Corv. the National Cory Family Society will present to the memorial committees check in memory of Giles and Martha Cory to help pay for this wonderful memorial. A marker will be placed at the memorial with the name of The National Cory Family Society. After this presentation, a wreath of flowers will be placed at the memorial in memory of our own Giles and Martha Cory. For those who wish to contribute to this special gift there will be a place to mark on your contributions on the sign-up sheet. For those of you not able to attend the reunion, yet would like to contribute, we would appreciate your gift also.

At 200 pm. we will board Busses for tours of The House of Seven Gables, made famous by the novel of the same name, written by Nataniel Hawthorne. Then it is off to Pioneer Village where we see life as it took place in 1630 Salem. A special surprise awaits all who attend this tour. Our guide on the bus will be none other

than GILES CORY. He will tell us a little about his life and his trial as a witch. It would be disappointing to miss this! The busses will deliver us to the Hawthorne Hotel about 5:15. At 6:15 we gather at the lobby for a walk to Victoria Station where we will dine on Lobster, Filet mignon, or Swordfish in our private dining room, overlooking Salem Bay. The remainder of the evening is free to spend as you wish. You may want to shop around Pickering Wharf after dinner or just head back to the Hotel to visit.

Sunday morning we will gather for those who wish to attend the church near the hotel. Our banquet and business meeting will begin at 1:00 p.m. at the Hotel. After our meal and business meeting, Lt Col Eleanor Spiller, a descendant of Giles Cory and author of the book The Progeny of William Cleaves of Beverly, Mass, will lecture on the Salem Witch Rials and the life and times of Giles Cory.
