Saturday we hope to have a tour of Temple Square in the Morning, which will tour the sites and historical saga of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Also Saturday morning our cousin Paul Corey will try to arrange a tour of the Mormon Library for us to become more familiar with what the Library has to offer. The rest of the day is dedicated to genealogical research in the Library or what ever you may want to do.

OUR LIBRARY VISIT

Hopefully I can shed some light on any ones first visit to the Mormon History Center's Libraries. Many of the Local Churches have Branch Libraries where you can do research and have access to just about every thing located in the main library in Salt Lake. To answer the first Question, No you don't have to belong to the Mormon faith to use their facilities. Marilee and I both work as Librarians in one of the Branches and we are not Mormons.

We are going to visit the Main Family History Library of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saint in Salt Lake.. The Library began in 1894, and since that beginning it has become the largest of its kind in the world. They have over 1.7 million rolls of microfilm records, over 200,00 books, 9 million family.
